HEDI KYLE'S FISHBONE STRUCTURE

Guest are invited to attend and can participate once all members have received the handouts and providing there are extra supplies.

What will be provided:

- 1. Instruction sheets for structure and cover
- 2. One sheet of paper

What to bring in addition to your regular bookbinding tool kit:

- All the sizes of the brass folding strips OR a 1/2" strip of book board OR a sturdy paper about 7" long. If you have a scoring tablet or a quilting ruler you can use those to measure and score
- Scoring tool (optional)
- · Metal ruler
- Triangle (metal if possible)
- Pencil
- · Bone folder
- Cutting mat
- Knife or scalpel
- Double-sided tape or glue and glue brush (plus waste paper to glue on)
- Needle and thread
- Reading glasses!

With the supplies provided, you will create an unembellished mock-up to keep for further experimentation. However if you wish bring your own decorated paper to work with or to create another structure or more, please take this opportunity!

Measurements and type of paper to bring (optional):

· The paper should run grain short (please see Mita's article in our newsletter

found at www.librosnm.org).

- Length of paper, at least 30" or longer. Arches Text Wove is a good paper to use and can be found at Takach Paper in 40" lengths (full sheet). Artisans also sell this paper, call for length. Arches Text Wove paper cannot be found at craft stores.
- Wait to cut the height until the meeting as the height of the book determined when paper is folded down in half.
- For this structure any type of paper you choose to use *must hold a crease*. Beverly often uses her paste paper decorated on both sides of the sheet.
- Bring a variety of paper to see what works best.
- Try using KraftTex for covers.
